Dear Mr. Boyce:

Section 3.2 of the referenced agreement, as amended on or about June 30, 2020, provides in part as follows:

Section 3.2 Effect of Termination. Within 90 days after the Commencement Date, Metro shall provide written notice to Signature to: (i) direct Signature to commence the orderly transition of all operations (a "Transition") of the Facility to a different provider (a "New Provider"); or (ii) direct Signature to undertake the orderly discontinuation of all operations at the Facility by transferring patients to other qualified facilities (a "Wind Down"). Signature shall conduct such Wind Down or Transition in compliance with all applicable laws and regulations.

As Signature has been advised, Metro solicited proposals for continuing operations at the facility by a different provider but received none. Accordingly, this is the written notice required by the provision quoted above for Signature to "undertake the orderly discontinuation of all operations at the Facility by transferring patients to other qualified facilities."
