Cloth Face Coverings or Masks—Required

- Face coverings are required by Metro Ordinance BL2020-285 and Public Health Order 8—Cloth Face Coverings or Masks Order
- General Contractors and Project Managers are responsible for ensuring their subcontractors and employees follow the order
- What is a face covering?
 - Cloth or mask that covers nose and mouth
 - Examples: cloth mask, scarf, bandana, or other material used to cover nose and mouth
 - Face coverings **must cover both the nose and mouth**
- Indoor areas
 - Face coverings must be worn indoors at all times unless:
 - working on ladders or other similar structures
 - wearing other required respiratory protection
 - heavy physical exertion
 - operating heavy equipment
 - medical exemptions
 - When face coverings are not being used, workers must be more than 6 feet apart
- Outdoor areas
 - Face coverings must be worn outside when workers cannot stay more than 6 feet apart
- Elevators and Hoists
 - Masks should be worn on all elevators and hoists
 - Social distancing must be observed on elevators and hoists, even when masks are used
- Visitors are required to wear face coverings
- Possible penalties imposed by MPHD or MNPD for violations include:
 - Fines
 - Conviction of Class C Misdemeanor
 - Suspension or revocation of permits
